Minneapolis Women's 500 Club Tournament Rules

1. Average Entry Requirements

Bowlers will use their highest final winter league average for the 2008-09 season for 21 games or more. If no winter average in a Minneapolis league is available, use the highest final average in a spring/summer league of 21 games or more. Bowlers not having a winter or spring league average will use their highest current certified league average for 12 games or more, just bring in the leagues current standing sheet signed by the league secretary and dated the week of March 21, 2010. Entrants who do not meet the above requirements will bowl scratch.

USBC rule 319a-3 (incorrect reporting of average) will apply. USBC rules 319a-2 (10 pin rule) & 319d (reporting of previous of previous tournament winnings) do not apply. Rule 319e waived.

2. Handicap

Handicap will be 100% of 200 for all bowlers, no limit.

3. Entry Fees

\$20.00 three (3) game series (\$8.50 bowling, \$3.00 expenses, \$1.00 dues, \$7.50 prize fund)

100% prize fund will be returned (1 out of 4).

4. Eligibility

This tournament is open to all women who have rolled a one time certified 500 series or have NOT had a 600 series in the past two bowling seasons and are a current member of the Minneapolis USBC Association for the 2009-10 season. A bowler may participate only once.

5. Termination Clause

The Minneapolis Women's 500 Club shall be responsible to return entry fees only in the event the tournament is prematurely terminated due to causes beyond the control of the Minneapolis Women's 500 Club such as fire, flood, natural emergency, labor trouble etc.

6. Miscellaneous Rules

No confirmation will be mailed – You will be notified if change is needed.

Please check in 30 minutes before the scheduled shift. No makeup frames are allowed. If you are unable to bowl the tournament, but wish to remain an active member of the Minneapolis Women's 500 Club, send your dues with this form to Diana Cacas. We welcome your attendance at the banquet and meeting even if you are not bowling. Guests are welcome.

Refunds – see rule 314, No refund for banquet reservations.
